EMERGENCIES

In the event of an emergency and you need to call 911, your location is:

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-In: 3pm or later, the day of your reservation

Check-Out: No later than 2pm

Please note: early arrival or late departure will result in an additional fee of \$10.00.

Please keep all of your equipment and vehicles on your site. No more than one unit plus a small tent and two

vehicles per lot.

CANCELLATIONS Cancellations with 10 days or more notice will be given a full refund minus a \$20.00 administration fee. No refund will be given with less than a 10 day notice.

QUIET HOURS & BOUNDARIES Quiet Hours: 11pm – 8am

In order to maintain good relations with our neighbors, we ask that you keep noise to appropriate levels at all times. We also ask that you respect neighbors' property and retreat groups using the retreat facilities by staying in Daisy Park. Please do not go beyond the campsites to the north, past the fence on the east side, or into the retreat area (unless there are no programs/retreat groups using this area).

VISITORS Visitors are welcome from **8am to 11pm**. There is no charge for visitors unless they stay overnight. The overnight rate is **\$5.00** per person per night. Please pay campground hosts for overnight visitors.

WATERFRONT The waterfront is a fun place to be at SON-Life, but please remember that extra caution and supervision is needed to keep it a safe place. Our waterfront area is split in the middle by a fence. The North side (blob side) is reserved weekday afternoons in the summer for our Summer Camp Program. The South side (boats side) is available during these hours for all campground guests. We ask that when the Summer Camp program arrives, all campground guests use only the south side of the waterfront for those afternoon hours. Please follow these basic waterfront rules when using the area:

- **1.** Campground Side Hours: **Dawn to Dusk** daily. Summer Camp Side: Reserved Weekdays from **1-4pm** for the SON-Life Summer Camp Program.
- 2. Waterfront and lake are closed after dark.
- 3. Adults (18 or older) must supervise the waterfront during usage. **Children under 18 must have adult supervision while swimming or boating.**
- 4. No running or diving on docks. Dive from floating rafts only.
- 5. Always swim or boat with a buddy.
- 6. No animals or glass containers on the beach.

BOATS Boats are available at no charge on a first come, first serve basis, with the exception of 1-4pm daily as they are reserved for the Summer Camp Program. We ask that you respect all our equipment by returning it to their storage locations. Please use extreme care when emptying water out of watercrafts and securely fasten the plugs when finished.

- 1. Boat Hours: Monday Friday: Dawn to 1:00PM & 4:00PM to Dusk
 Saturday Sunday: Dawn to Dusk
- 2. No boating after dark.

- 3. All boaters must wear life jackets.
- 4. Personal boats may be carried in. No boat launching. No gas motors trolling motors only.
- 5. Always return lifejackets, paddles, and boats to storage locations. Please do not leave boats on the beach or by edge of water. Paddleboats must be returned and securely clipped to the paddleboat dock.
- 6. Do not fill boats beyond maximum seating capacity.
- 7. No boats in swimming area. Paddle boards are considered a boat.

FISHING No fishing from beach area docks. Please use north docks or rowboats.

BLOB The blob and stairway tower are closed and off-limits except during pre-scheduled programmed times with SON-Life staff only. A **\$125.00** fine will be issued for anyone using this area without SON-Life supervision.

CLEANING FISH Please use only the Fish House to clean all fish. No cleaning fish at the campsite or beach or on any of SON-Life Camp's picnic tables. Please put place fish waste in the freezer in the Fish House to eliminate odor. Please do not throw fish waste back into the lake.



ANIMALS We are a pet friendly campground. However, all pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet AT ALL TIMES and need to be cleaned up after. Pets are not allowed in buildings or the waterfront areas. This includes the beach and swim areas. Out of respect for other campground guests, please keep barking to a minimum. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.

PAVILLION & GROUP CAMPFIRE PIT Groups may reserve use of the pavilion and group campfire pit by contacting the campground host or by stopping up at the office. If a group has reserved the pavilion, it will be posted. If the pavilion is not reserved, individuals may use the pavilion. Please clean up behind yourselves (wash tables, sweeping, emptying garbage, and turning off lights).

CARE OF FACILITIES We are proud of our facilities and ask for your help in keeping them in the same condition you found them in.

- 1. Please keep your campsite clean and dispose of all trash properly. Bagged trash should be disposed of in the dumpster by the snack shack. Do not burn trash or food.
- 2. Campfires are only allowed in fire rings. Please do not move fire rings.
- 3. Help us keep our area natural and beautiful by not littering or destroying/defacing trees, bushes, grass, picnic tables, and buildings.
- 4. Please help us conserve energy by turning off lights when leaving bathrooms, and any camp buildings.
- 5. Please dispose of all gray water and wastes at the dump station and clean up any spills.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES & EQUIPMENT Alcoholic beverages, marijuana, and illegal drugs are prohibited on camp property. No smoking allowed in any building, or near Waterfront. Weapons and hunting/archery equipment prohibited.

ACCIDENTS & DAMAGES Please report all injuries and damages to camp staff or campground host before you leave. This includes screens, doors, waterfront equipment, lights, and anything missing or broken. For damages, an itemized invoice of charges will be sent to you. There is a \$125.00 fee for flipping any of the swim area rafts.

SEVERE WEATHER In the event of severe weather, please go to the Bathhouse showers in the campground, or to the basement of the Retreat Center.
